



GRAPE MEAL

Grape Meal is a by-product of oilseed processing, derived after the extraction of grape oil. The remaining mix is dried, steam flaked and cooked to ensure protein availability. Drying also increases ease of handling and prevents mould for long term storage. Grape Meal is a good source of protein and soluble and insoluble fibre for ruminant animals.
