Cottonseed hulls are derived from the process of dehulling whole cottonseed. This product can be fed to cattle, sheep and goats intensively and extensively raised as an effective fibre source.

### Feeding Guidelines

Cottonseed Hulls can be included in rations for beef and dairy cattle, sheep and goats as an excellent source of effective fibre and rumen mat in feedlot rations. This product can also be fed as an effective fibre supplement to ruminants grazing lush green pastures to promote cud chewing and improve rumen health. Supply in troughs or trailed on the ground over a sensible distance every 2-3 days. Consult your nutritionist for recommended inclusion levels and feeding rates.
